The Patient-Driven Values in Healthcare Evaluation (PAVE) Center at the University of Maryland School of Pharmacy was established in 2018 with funding from the **PhRMA Foundation** as a Center of Excellence in Value Assessment. Over the past four years, the Center expanded its patient-centered research in chronic obstructive pulmonary disease and major depressive disorder and is examining values related to telehealth and inequality aversion. Our team is establishing methods for eliciting, quantifying, and translating patient-informed value elements into value assessment with real-world applications.

PAVE is a Center of Excellence in Patient-Driven Value Assessment dedicated to promoting value-based decision-making through a diverse multi-stakeholder collaboration and engaging patients from an extensive network of partners to build technical expertise in patient-centered outcomes research, education, and dissemination.
